

MRMCD111b Call for Papers

Overview

The MetaRheinMain ChaosDays is an annual congress, this year with a focus on journalism, society and technology, organized by c3f2m Frankfurt, CCCmz (Mainz/Wiesbaden), the campus group Chaos Darmstadt, the AK Vorrat and other regional groups in the Rhein-Main-Neckar area. The MRMCDs will take place from September 5th to 7th at the Technische Universität Darmstadt.

Topics

We are interested in talks and workshops that are of interest to the general public, as well as talks about special topics. By this means it is assured that the talks are of general interests and also related to the scientific community. The event focuses on the following topics:

Journalism **Society** **Technology**

This includes, but is not limited to: voting machines, surveillance, cryptography, IT security, biometrics, data retention, electronic health card, evolution of technology and its impact on society, nerd culture, project management and self-organization.

Proceedings

The proceedings will be published. All authors are required to appropriately license their submissions, allowing us to reproduce and publish them without violating copyright law.

Timeline

Authors are required to submit abstracts of their talks and workshops by July 24th 2008, 23:59 PM CEST. Notification to authors will be sent on August 7th. Selected works must be submitted as full paper by August 25th. All submissions will be electronic, through the [Pentabarf](#) Conference System.

Formalities

Talks shall last 50 or 110 minutes, discussion time included. Longer talks and workshops can be arranged with the organizers on a case-to-case basis. All authors are required to provide the following information:

- Full name
- Short biography (no more than 200 words)
- Public contact

Language

Preferred conference language is German. If you are more comfortable talking in English, you may, at your discretion, decide to submit your proceedings and/or give your talk in English.

Miscellaneous

As in common practice, participation is voluntary; no fees are paid to authors.
